Abstract - Swespine

Swespine developed during 1993-1998-2023. Responsible for running the register is a steering group with representatives from surgeons, nurses, physiotherapists, primary care and the patients. 2023, the coverage is 98%, the completeness >85% and one year FU via PROM 70%. The register is financed by the gouvernement, and produces annual reports. Case-mix adjusted outcome clinic-wise camparable is publicly reported on a Home page; https://vardenisiffror.se/. Data are used by clnics for securing and immproving quality of care, and for research. Most research in spine surgery today use register data. Since 2000, 194 such studies have been published in international journals, and 19 dissertaions rely on these data. Swespine data has had important significance for routine about some surgical procedures, f ex Lumbar Spinal Stenosis. International cooperation is ongoing.
